November 2025 Election PROPOSITIONS: 1. Creates a permanent infrastructure fund and workforce education fund to support capital needs related to education programs at Texas State Technical College. 2. Prohibits any state-imposed tax on realized or unrealized capital gains of individuals, families, estates, or 3. Requires judges to deny bail in certain felony cases under specific conditions. 4. Dedicates a portion of sales and use taxes to the Texas Water Fund. 5. Authorizes the legislature to exempt f<mark>rom ad valore</mark>m taxes animal feed to be sold at retail. 6. Prohibits the legislature from imposin<mark>g occupationa</mark>l taxes on certain entities that convey securities or imposing a tax on certain securities transactions. 7. Authorizes the legislature to provide for a property tax exemption for the surviving spouse of a veteran who died from a service-related condition or disease. 8. Prohibits the legislature from imposing "death taxes" s<mark>uch as in</mark>heritance, e<mark>state,</mark> or gift taxes. 9. Authorizes the legislature to exempt from ad <mark>valorem taxes a portion of the ma</mark>rket value of personal property used to produce income. 10. Authorizes a temporary property tax exemption on homestead improvements completely damaged or destroyed by fire. 11. Temporarily increases the property tax exemption for elderly or disabled Texans by school districts from \$10,000 to \$60,000; effective 1/1/25 through 1/1/27. 12. Allows for changes to the State Commission on Judicial Conduct that will enable more effective sanctions against judges and justices for judicial misconduct. 13. Increases the amount of the exemption of residence homesteads from ad valorem taxation by a school district from \$100,000 to \$140,000. 14. Allows for establishment <mark>of a Dementia Prevention and Rese</mark>arch I<mark>nsti</mark>tute, establishes a related fund and transfers \$3 billion from general revenue to that fund. 15. Affirms that parents are the primary decision-makers for their children. 16. Clarifies that only U.S. citizens may vote in Texas elections. 17.Authorizes a property tax exemption for border security infrastructure and improvements in counties that border Mexico. **Woodlands Township:** Adam Lamb
